How to Forgive Yourself: Letting Go of Guilt and Past Regret




Now repent of your sins and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped away. Then times of refreshment will come from the presence of the Lord -Peter (Acts 3:19-20)

Question: How can know am forgiven... Again?

Answer:

Turn to Jesus and believe, and you will experience the forgiven life.



1) Humble yourself.

When Simon Peter realized what had happened, he fell to his knees before Jesus and said, "Oh, Lord, please leave me - I'm such a sinful man." -Peter (Luke 5:8)

Know yourself. I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well. -Psalm 139:14

• Know God.

Remember the things I have done in the past. For I alone am God! I am God, and there is none like me. -Isaiah 46:9

There is one God, and you are not him. -Frank Turek

There is but one good; that is God. Everything else is good when it looks to Him and bad when it turns from Him. -CS Lewis

Know yourself. Know God.

For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard. -Romans 3:23 Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up in honor. -James 4:10

2) Confess who He

is.

Simon Peter answered, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living

God."

-Peter (Matthew 16:16)

Know what you know.

Know what you don't know.

To be crucified means, first, the man of the cross is facing only one direction; second, he is not going back; and third, he has no further plans of his own. A.W. Tozer

3) Admit failure.

And Peter left the courtyard, weeping bitterly. -Luke 22:62

•We fail.

If we claim we have no sin, we are only fooling ourselves and not living in the truth. -1 John 1:8

• Then the test comes.

But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness. -1 John 1:9

Alfred Pennyworth: Why do we fall sir? So that we can learn to pick ourselves up.

Bruce Wayne: You still haven't given up on me?

4) Listen to grace.

A third time he asked him, "Simon son of John, do you love me?" Peter was hurt that Jesus asked the question a third time. He said, "Lord, you know everything. You know that I love you." Jesus said, "Then feed my sheep. -John 21:17

What does it look like to listen to His grace?

Seek him in brokenness
Accept His acceptance
Celebrate reconciliation

5) Live in response.

But Peter, standing with the eleven, lifted up his voice and addressed

them:

-Acts 2:14

Peter Preaches to the Crowd

14 Then Peter stepped forward with the eleven other apostles and shouted to the crowd, "Listen carefully, all of you, fellow Jews and residents of Jerusalem! Make no mistake about this. 15 These people are not drunk, as some of you are assuming. Nine o'clock in the morning is much too early for that. 16 No, what you see was predicted long ago by the prophet Joel:

- 'In the last days,' God says, 'I will pour out my Spirit upon all people.
- Your sons and daughters will prophesy.
- Your young men will see visions,
- and your old men will dream dreams.
- 18
- In those days I will pour out my Spirit even on my servants—men and women alike—
- and they will prophesy.
- 19
- And I will cause wonders in the heavens above and signs on the earth below—
- blood and fire and clouds of smoke.

The sun will become dark,

22 "People of Israel, listen! God publicly endorsed Jesus the Nazarene[d] by doing powerful miracles, wonders, and signs through him, as you well know. 23 But God knew what would happen, and his prearranged plan was carried out when Jesus was betrayed. With the help of lawless Gentiles, you nailed him to a cross and killed him. 24 But God released him from the horrors of death and raised him back to life, for death could not keep him in its grip. 25 King David said this about him: 'I see that the Lord is always with me.

I will not be shaken, for he is right beside me.

29 "Dear brothers, think about this! You can be sure that the patriarch David wasn't referring to himself, for he died and was buried, and his tomb is still here among us. 30 But he was a prophet, and he knew God had promised with an oath that one of David's own descendants would sit on his throne. 31 David was looking into the future and speaking of the Messiah's resurrection. He was saying that God would not leave him among the dead or allow his body to rot in the grave.

32 "God raised Jesus from the dead, and we are all witnesses of this. 33 Now he is exalted to the place of highest honor in heaven, at God's right hand. And the Father, as he had promised, gave him the Holy Spirit to pour out upon us, just as you see and hear today. 34 For David himself never ascended into heaven, yet he said,

'The Lord said to my Lord,

"Sit in the place of honor at my right hand

36 "So let everyone in Israel know for certain that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, to be both Lord and Messiah!"

37 Peter's words pierced their hearts, and they said to him and to the other apostles, "Brothers, what should we do?"

38 Peter replied. "Each of your must repent of your sins and turn to God, and be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. Then you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit, 39 This promise is to you, to your children, and to those far
