We read five Bible passages this weekend, which speak about “going” to share God’s good news of Jesus: Matthew 28:16-20, Mark 16:14-18, Luke 24:44-49, John 20:19-23 and Acts 1:4-8.

One example of this is *Excel Leadership Network* with whom we partner. They planted #31 churches this year! Visit them at: **excelnetwork.org** to find out more about their vision.

3. Take some time in your group to pray for Excel Leadership Network and the #31 couples who planted a church this year.

In Matthew 28:16-20, Jesus commissions his disciples to go throughout the whole earth. Read through this Bible passage in at least 2 different translations.

4. Whether or not this passage is familiar to you, how did reading different translations bring fresh or meaningful application?

5. What kind of “mindset shift” do you need to make to follow Jesus in a way that results in the *Kingdom Shift*, which Pastor David spoke of?

6. How do Philippians 2:5-11 and Luke 19:10 describe this *shift*?
