Meaningful variant?

Variants that are meaningful and viable are the ones that deserve our full attention.... This is the smallest category of variants - fewer than 1% of the 400,000. AFCIT -William Mounce

Summary •5,600 Greek manuscripts •400,000 textual variants •99% are either not meaningful or not viable Less than 1% are meaningful and viable, and no doctrine impacted.
