How does Jesus fulfill our need for community?

1. By giving us purpose.

- Defining Community
- If you don't have purpose, you probably won't have community.
- What is your purpose?
- And it is impossible to please God without faith. Anyone
 who wants to come to him must believe that God exists
 and that he rewards those who sincerely seek him.
 - -Hebrews 11:6
- Man's chief end is to glorify God, and to enjoy him forever. -Westminster Shorter Catechism

- The goal is not success, but intimacy.
- How to seek intimacy with God?
- Love God and do what you want. -Augustine

2. By making us humble.

- Defining humility
- Humility is not thinking less of yourself, but thinking of yourself less," C.S. Lewis
- · Humility leads to community.
- · How can we cultivate humility?

3. By empowering us to Love.

- This is real love not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins. -1 John 4:10
- For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. -John 3:16
