QUESTIONS TO CONSIDER

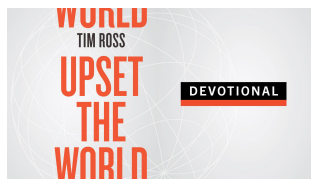
1. What stood out to you from this week’s sermon? Share it with someone!

Jesus Really Walked With His Disciples.

- Jesus of history vs. Jesus of faith. - 1 Peter 5:13

Why Were The Gospels Written Later Than The Events They Record?

If We Say That The Gospels Are Trustworthy, Then What Do They Say About Jesus?

- Directly they say that Jesus is God. - John 8:57-59

- Indirectly we know God wants a relationship with you because of whom he chose to write the Gospels.

- Acts 13:13 - Acts 15:38-40 - Luke 1:1-4

If We Can Trust The Gospels, Then We Need To Be In The Word Walking With Jesus As He Walks With Us.

- Genesis 1:1-3 - John 15:9 -

The Authenticity Of Who Jesus Is Invites Us To Walk With Him.

If Jesus Is Who The Gospels Say He Is, Walking With Him Is Critical To Our Life.
