Our primary identity is not as a “Christian”.  
It is “**I am the Beloved of God because of Jesus.**”  
“**I am a follower of Jesus.**”

  1. **Jesus Is For Everyone**  
Matthew 28:18–20 (NLT)
  
  2. **Jesus Offers A New Identity**  
Galatians 2:20 (ESV)
    - This is Good News, NOT good advice.
    - This is not behavior modification
    - Behavior and Action Come From Identity
  
  3. **The Gospel Changes Everything - Not Just Individual Lives**

### GETTING STARTED

Jesus taught and practiced that all people mattered equally to God. Paul announced, "the idea that Christ died for all of humanity." The accompanying truth was that "there is no Jew or Greek" (Galatians 5:26-29), "...that difference is dissolved..." (T. Holland).

### DISCUSSION

1. **Jesus' ideas revolutionary when they emerged. How much do they still matter today to followers of Jesus, Western culture and the wider world?**
2. **What do you think about Karl's 4 factors that he sees as important for the swift spread of Christian faith to the ends of the earth?**

- 1) The validity of Jesus' life
- 2) The evidence for him being the Son of God, not just a religious teacher
- 3) Jesus "sending" his followers into the world
- 4) The power of the Spirit in people's lives

Dana Robert considers the concept of a "network" or "chain" in the life of each of Jesus' followers, linking them, ultimately, back to Jesus, his people the Jews and his call from God.

**3. Share the various chain links that have brought you to this point in your faith journey.**

A key link in the chain that formed the spread of early Christianity was the radical conversion of Saul (Paul) from fanatical persecutor of Christians to passionate promoter of the faith.

**4. Have you experienced the kind of “Damascus road” encounter that Paul experienced (Acts 9:1-19)? What is your response to the biblical story and/or your experience?**

Pastor David spoke about 3 points to keep from getting “bored with Jesus: ‘Know, Experience, Do’.” He pointed out that, “If your faith is convenient, it isn’t faith and it is dying.”

**5. How does the following question strike you: “When was the last time you lived your faith in such a way that you had to depend on Jesus because it was greater than you?”**

**ACTION**

This weekend we heard that behavior and action come from identity (Galatians 2:20). Pastor David said, “Stop trying to be a Christian. Be this: ‘I am the Beloved of God because of Jesus. I am a follower of Jesus.’”

**6. What difference does the above distinction make? What difference does the Gospel make?**
