5. Read 1 Corinthians 10:12. How do these warnings relate to each other?

6. How are both kindness and severity reflections of God's character of love? (11:22)



7. The underlying message of this chapter is the same as throughout the letter to the Roman church - a life connected to God is a life of faith, nothing more, nothing less. What does this mean for you personally? How are you living a life of faith?

8. Of the four things the message talked about of How Then Should We Live, where are you strongest? Where do you need to grow? What can you do this week to grow in your life of faith?

BEING “ON MISSION”
