ICE BREAKER: Describe an experience you have had with someone you respected stating a belief vastly different than yours? What happened?

PRAYER: God is worthy to be sought - take time to pray together in your group.

EXPLORING TOGETHER

There is value in sharing perspectives about the weekend message in community. With dialogue around God’s truths, perspective broadens and impacts transformation.

1. What is something from this weekend’s message that stood out to you? How so?
2. What is your experience of prophetic revelation—either having someone pass on a “word from the lord” or sensing/hearing God speak to you directly?

GOING DEEPER

3. False prophecy was a significant issue in the early church. What do the statements in the following verses say to you: 2 Peter 2:1–2; 1 John 4:1; Romans 16:17; Colossians 2:8?
4. How do we investigate whether or not a presented “God told me...” is genuine or accurate? What do we do if a presented “God told me...” is regarded as inaccurate or incorrect?
5. Jesus placed a lot of significance on the “fruit” of a prophet’s life or ministry. What does this mean? What does it not mean? (Galatians 5:22-24)
6. People who deliberately lead others astray by false prophecy are obviously culpable. But what about those who accept or allow themselves to be deceived? What responsibility do they have?

WEEKLY REFLECTION - NEXT STEPS

The **fruit of the Spirit** are not a set of beliefs, they are the actions that reveal the transforming power of God’s Spirit at work in our life because of the **resurrection power of Jesus** in us. (Romans 8:11) The life of following Jesus is shown in what we do, greatly impacted by **who we listen to**.

7. What do you need to *surrender, follow, listen* or *do* to increasingly become (or help someone else become) a person who listens to **Jesus, Scripture, Godly people you know, turning off the noise?**

At Cold Springs we talk about the next steps as:

Surrender your position as the Gold Standard, as judge

Follow Jesus’ example of love lived - be a person of grace and mercy

Listen to the voice of Jesus when tempted to judge - he touched people with compassion
