ICE BREAKER: Read the following phrase together: *Discovering how God made me.* Take turns going around the room saying one word that comes to your mind in relation to the phrase. Discuss the differences and commonalities voiced.

PRAYER: Our desire is that you give 10% of your time to God in prayer. Take time to pray together in your group.

THIS WEEK: In this new sermon series we begin to explore how to follow Jesus in the way we were designed.

1. Looking back at your notes from this week's message, what caught your attention, encouraged or challenged you?

2. The big sign on our Worship Center wall reads: "**Free to be who we are, BEING transformed into all God wants us to be.**" What does this phrase mean to you?

Read Psalm 139:14.

3. When you consider how you are designed, what do you like? What don't you like?



4. What is it about your interactions with others that you find creates tension or discomfort?

5. What is the value of understanding *why we do what we do*?

TAKING IT HOME

We see uniqueness all around us in God's creation. We can forget to attribute and validate God's creative differences within ourselves and those around us. In the past couple of weeks Pastor David has mentioned that *our transformation* is the hope of the Gospel.

6. What preconceived notions do you (or those around you) have about what a real relationship with Jesus is "supposed" to look like?

Read Acts 26:20. This passage clearly delineates 3 steps to the *transforming* power of the Gospel:

- A. *Repent of your sins.*
- B. *Turn to God.*
- C. *Live differently - Do good.*

7. Which of these 3 steps do you find challenging in this season? What gives you hope?

Too many times people think loving Jesus and loving others requires them to lose themselves and aspire to be this bland person who is "perfect." What if God intentionally made you unique and you experienced God and others when you lived fully out of that uniqueness and accepted the uniqueness of others?

8. How can you leverage the way God shaped you in order to experience him more deeply?
