- They are us (1 Corinthians 6:9–11)

- **Simon**

- There are at least two passages that describe Jesus healing leprosy:

i) One in Luke where 10 lepers are healed. Only one returns to thank Jesus and he is a Samaritan.

ii) in Matthew where a leper is healed. Perhaps this is Simon.

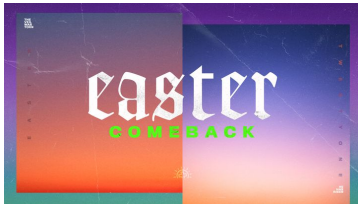

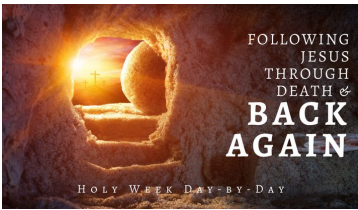


### Easter: Come Back
