- With: Reimagining The Way You Relate To God
 - I. **Life Under God** - control by securing God's blessings through religion and morality.
 - II. **Life Over God** - control by following natural laws or divine principles.
 - III. **Life From God** - control by amassing wealth, health and popularity so you don't need anything.
 - IV. **Life For God** - control by serving God so he owes you blessing and protection.

- **Two Kinds of Faith**

- i) Confessional Faith

"If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by openly declaring your faith that you are saved."

(Romans 10:9-10, NLT)

- ii) Experiential Faith

"It is the experiential knowledge of God's love - his unyielding goodness toward us - that delivers us from fear and gives us the courage to surrender to him." "With" p.121

"What good is it, dear brothers and sisters, if you say you have faith but don't show it by your actions? Can that kind of faith save anyone?" (James 2:14, NLT)

- Workers, do your work for that jerk of a boss or jerk of an organization like they are Jesus themselves so you do everything with joy and excellence
- Church, step closer to the broken, the mentally ill, the hurting, the notorious sinners to be the extraordinarily imperfect hands, feet, voice and love of Jesus.
